

## **Guidance from Bishop Martin about public worship at this time**

- It is now compulsory to wear a face covering in places of worship, except for those with a medical exemption.
- We have to maintain the 2 metre rule unless sitting with people from the same household or our personal 'bubble'; the pews are marked and chairs placed in appropriate places.
- Nobody is allowed to sing, though Martin will play the organ, quietly, at appropriate times.
- Only bread will be distributed at the Communion and Fr. David will take extra care not to touch anyone's hands.
- Communicants should wait until previous people have resumed their seats before leaving theirs, as indicated by the Sidespeople.
- Entry for both services will be via the North Door, unless you find that too difficult, then entry can be arranged via the Vestry.
- Everyone will be required to apply sanitiser, provided, to their hands on entry.
- Printed Service Sheets will be available at 10.00a.m. Please take them home with you for disposal.
- Cream order of Service booklets will be available for 8.00a.m.; please take them home with you whilst the pandemic is still active.
- Sidespeople will be making a note of all attendees in case of a need to 'track and trace'.
- Sidespeople will be on hand to help everyone through this new experience; please ask if you have any queries or concerns.
- There will be no Collection made during the Service but a plate will be available together with the machine for contactless donations.
- At the end of the Service, please move outside as quickly as possible, maintaining social distancing.
- There will be no refreshments served.
- Maximum of 30 people may attend whilst space is so limited, so come early!
